SMYRNA HIGH SCHOOL BAND INFORMATION

Being in high school band is one of the most educational and memorable activities a student will ever participate in! But you should also know that band is unlike any other activity at Smyrna High School. Yes, it meets like a class during the school day, but the activity also includes **required after-school practices**, plus a few weekends for practices, contests and parades. All of these times outside of the regular class time are a **REQUIRED** part of the class. And the student's success and grades depend upon their participation.

As you read through this information, we know this packet is lengthy and it can seem overwhelming at first, but please take the time to read it carefully. We want to be up front with the **time and commitment** it takes to be part of this activity. And we are more than happy to answer any questions you may have. By returning the attached **signed contract and medical release form** you acknowledge that you and your child understands the total commitment that is necessary.

Being in a High School Band involves several different parts throughout the year: Concert Band, Pep Band & Marching Band. The marching band season (though only a portion of the overall annual band curriculum) goes from late July through October. This class begins at the end of July at "**Band Camp**" to prepare for the marching season (football games and marching contests). Most of our halftime show is taught during band camp.

Because of the rehearsal schedule the marching band portion does conflict with several **fall sports** and extra-curricular activities. (If you are on a Smyrna High School fall sports team and also wish to participate in band, it is possible to do both, and individual cases will be evaluated by Mr. Reagh.) There are NO major conflicts with winter or spring sports, and we can work with anything we know about in advance.

Marching Band is the ultimate **team activity** with each member dependent on every other member being present. So, if a student misses (or even worse- quits), then the entire team suffers.

After football season concludes, the initial busy schedule does ease up quite a bit. Most of the rest of the year is spent preparing for concerts, honor bands, the Smyrna Christmas Parade, Solo/Ensemble, and Concert Performance Assessment, but with fewer after-school practices.

So, please look at the initial schedule below and all parts of this info packet before making the commitment to join the Smyrna High School Band. We encourage you to make the sacrifices necessary for your child to take advantage of this incredible activity that will help them to: develop their **thinking skills** and other **essential life skills**, mature into adulthood, become better members of society, and will provide them (and their parents) a lifetime of memories and friendships!

MARCHING BAND – time outside of class

After School Practices August-October:

Most Weeks: Guard & Percussion: Mondays & Thursdays 3:45-6:00
Woodwinds & Brass: Tuesdays & Thursdays 3:45-6:00

*Any week with a day out of school, a Thursday football game, or other alterations to a normal 5-day week will have a slightly different schedule. See the “*Marching Band Calendar*” for full rehearsal schedule.

Marching Performances:

Every home football game – regular season and play-offs (Thursday or Friday nights from Aug-Nov)

Select away games - regular season and play-offs

Competitions - are on Saturdays in Sept. and Oct. (usually 3 of them total)

Christmas Parade - usually 1st Sunday afternoon in December

Pep Band Performances:

Most football games – regular season and play-offs (Thursday or Friday nights from Aug-Nov)

CONCERT BAND – time outside of class

After School Rehearsals:

-A few other rehearsals will be scheduled throughout the year as needed to help prepare for the parade, CPA, and prior to each concert.

-Typically does not exceed 1 rehearsal/week and not every week.

-These dates will be announced later in the year
