- Football program ads & question from Casual Pint Owner (Tammy): all ads money wise. Early bird has past all ads due by July 31st. Senior ads are needed half page is \$50 and quarter page is \$25. Mexican Food market card. How many do we need to order. We made \$2625 from ad income. Order 200 boxes. Do a sign-up to help with table sells.

- Orientation to football game days for new parents:
- Schedules for game days is posted in the band room and on the band website the week of the game, times are listed when the band room opens, dress time (if in full uniform), uniform inspection, pre-game rehearsal, and bus loading time (for away games) or assembly for march into the stadium (home games).
- All kids should eat BEFORE dress time-Kids can go home as long as they follow schedule around 5:30pm
- Review of August calendar: After school practice for all students on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays every week, 3:45pm-5:45pm
- Football game schedule for August:
 1. First football game Friday 8/18 (away at Riverdale)
 2. First home game 8/25 vs. Rockvale
- Volunteers are needed for all football games (home and away)
- Away games: pre-game prep & bus chaperones (at least 3 per bus for 3 buses)
- Home games: pre-game prep starts at 4pm. Ice waters in coolers, help with uniform dress & inspection, game time chaperones, pit crew placement & show props at halftime, stands cleanup, Final Formation/band room cleanup.
- Volunteers who help game prep, game time tasks, and after game cleanup may attend the games for free with the band, but you must have a pass to get in and the pass must be turned back in after the game. There are a limited number of game passes.
- Band platform in the football stands has been replaced, thanks to Garin Steffey & Joel Poole for volunteering their time.

New business added: Marching shoes: Band pay for the 1st year for freshman and anyone else needing a new pair pays \$35.
